### OVERVIEW

Bayfield Ventures Corp. (TSX-V: BYV) is exploring for gold and silver in the Rainy River district of northwestern Ontario.

Bayfield owns 100% of the mineral rights to its flagship "Burns" Block property which is located in the Richardson Township, Rainy River District of northwestern Ontario. The property is surrounded by [Rainy River Resources \(TSX: RR\)](#) property and adjoins the immediate east of Rainy River Resources' main ODM17 gold-silver deposit and to the west of their expanding Intrepid gold-silver zone. The Burns Block property is subject to a 2% NSR.

Drilling to date on the western side of the Burns Block demonstrates that the ODM17 Zone extends from Rainy River Resources' ground onto Bayfield's Burns Block. Notable drill results from Bayfield's current ongoing 100,000 metre drill program include 60.05 g/t gold and 362.96 g/t silver over 11.2 metres within 26.70 g/t gold and 170.69 g/t silver over 25.5 metres in hole RR11-71, as well as 35.93 g/t gold and 359.65 g/t silver over 10.0 metres in hole RR10-18.

The Company is currently focused on drilling a newly discovered high grade gold-silver zone on the eastern side of the Burns Block. Bayfield continues to drill test the down-plunge extension of this expanding mineralized zone which is projected to be the down-dip portion of Rainy River Resources newly discovered Intrepid Zone. Notable early results from the zone include 6.60 grams per tonne gold and 34.20 g/t silver over 25.50 metres including 11.06 g/t gold and 57.05 g/t silver over 15.00 metres in wedge hole RR12-34W1, 5.45 g/t gold and 20.63 g/t silver over 19.60 metres in hole RR12-30, and 12.19 g/t gold and 30.05 g/t silver over 11.90 metres in hole RR 13-07.

Bayfield Ventures is consistently proving up lower grade, bulk tonnage gold and silver mineralization as well as high-grade gold and silver zones on the Burns Block property.

Rainy River Resources October 2012 resource calculation shows a measured and indicated resource of 6.17 million of gold averaging 1.21 g/t gold, in addition to an inferred resource of 2.28 million ounces of gold averaging 0.75 g/t gold. The deposit also contains a measured and indicated resource of 13.34 million ounces of silver averaging 2.62 g/t silver, in addition to an inferred resource of 6.98 million ounces of silver averaging 2.32 g/t silver.

## “Burns” Block Property, Rainy River District, NW Ontario (Flagship Project)

- 100% owned mineral rights in the “Burns” claim block located in the Richardson Township, Rainy River District of northwestern Ontario. Bayfield’s Burns Block is surrounded by Rainy River Resources (TSX: RR) and adjoins the immediate east of Rainy River Resources’ main ODM17 gold deposit and to the west of their expanding Intrepid gold-silver zone.
- Rainy River’s October 2012 NI 43-101 resource estimate shows a measured and indicated resource of 6.17 million of gold averaging 1.21 g/t gold, in addition to an inferred resource of 2.28 million ounces of gold averaging 0.75 g/t gold. The deposit also contains a measured and indicated resource of 13.34 million ounces of silver averaging 2.62 g/t silver, in addition to an inferred resource of 6.98 million ounces of silver averaging 2.32 g/t silver.
- Bayfield is currently carrying out 100,000 metres of diamond drilling on its Rainy River properties (majority of drilling to be done on Burns Block).
- The gold and silver results thus far in the program have been very successful in delineating the eastern extension of Rainy River’s main ODM17 gold zone onto the Burns Block as Bayfield continues to intersect lower grade, bulk tonnage gold mineralization as well as higher grade gold and silver zones.
- Notable high grade drill results include:
  - **RR11-71** → 60.05 g/t Au and 362.96 g/t Ag over 11.2m within 25.5m of 26.70 g/t Au and 170.69 g/t Ag
  - **RR11-181** → 61.02 g/t Au over 7.2m within 33.0m of 13.73 g/t Au
  - **RR11-180** → 65.66 g/t Au over 5.0m within 30.0m of 12.98 g/t Au
  - **RR10-18** → 35.93 g/t Au and 359.65 g/t Ag over 10.0m
  - **RR10-15** → 31.71 g/t Au over 3.0m within 9.0m of 12.88 g/t Au
  - **RR11-162** → 20.23 g/t Au over 5.5m within 10.0m of 11.22 g/t Au
  - **RR11-1** → 33.13 g/t Au over 2.2m within 9.15m of 8.37 g/t Au
  - **RR12-26** → 10.39 g/t Au and 191.32 g/t Ag over 5.5m
  - **RR12-30** → 5.45 g/t Au and 20.63 g/t Ag over 19.6m
  - **RR12-34** → 17.04 g/t Au and 79.07 g/t Ag over 11.60m within 26.5m of 8.82 g/t Au and 39.44 g/t Ag
  - **RR12-34W1** → 11.06 g/t Au and 57.05 g/t Ag over 15.0m within 6.6 g/t Au and 34.2 g/t Ag over 25.5m
  - **RR 13-7** → 12.19 g/t Au and 30.05 g/t Ag over 11.9m within 8.1 g/t Au and 20.55 g/t Ag over 22.9m
- Recent drilling at Burns focused on rapidly expanding East Burns – Intrepid Au-Ag Zone.
- A wide shear zone at the East Burns – Intrepid Zone is being explored and appears to be the far easterly strike extension of the main ODM17 gold-silver zone which hosts most of Rainy River’s deposit and Bayfield’s high grade gold-silver zones 600-700 metres to the west.
- Rainy River’s Intrepid Zone represents up-dip extension of East Burns High Grade Zone and further step-out drilling to southwest is ongoing to test high grade gold-silver zone which remains open down-dip and displays tendency for increasing grade at depth at East Burns.

## Claim Block “B” and Claim Block “C” Properties, Rainy River District, NW Ontario

- Bayfield also holds 100% mineral rights in the 480 acre “B” Claim Block which is well located to the immediate east of Rainy River Resources’ northerly 433 gold zone. To the west, Bayfield owns 100% mineral rights in the strategically located 1976 acre “C” Block property.
- A diamond drill rig has just finished conducting reconnaissance exploration of the large “C” Block to the west. The “C” Block has had no previous diamond drilling done on it.
- All of Bayfield’s properties cover similar lithologies and structures to those hosting the gold zones on Rainy River Resources’ property.
